Mr Y S is no more able to lifting tiles & heavy goods as he used to for the last 20 years..He has now difficulty in moving. He is walking very slowly with too much discomfort &has severe pain mainly at night. Mr Y. S is very rigid & leans forward on walking to ease his pain. Hot foments on his back also improves the pain . On examination:

Painful walking, Bilateral Back Pain on active SLR but not in passive SLR. Tender mainly L4 spine associated with bilateral paraspinal tenderness. This tenderness is exaggerated by HIP EXTENSION on both sides.

He has also bilateral pain in the lower back which is elicited on each side by flexion of hip & knee AND INTERNAL ROTATION.
